Retail Prescription Program	Walmart, CVS, Walgreens, Costco, Rite Aid, etc.	Most retail pharmacy chains offer their own cost savings programs to their customers. Ask your pharmacy for details.
Rx Outreach	www.rxoutreach.org	Non-profit mail order pharmacy; provides medications at a discount to patients that meet certain financial criteria.
ShopRite	Any retail ShopRite Pharmacy location	ShopRite Pharmacy offers a Diabetic Program which fills certain generic diabetes medications at no cost to the patient.
Catholic Charities Community Services of Dutchess	(845) 452-1400 *Dutchess County only	Charity program offering emergency financial assistance to those who qualify.
Dutchess Outreach	(845) 454-3792 *Dutchess County only	Local agency offering an emergency relief program; provides one-time financial grant to those who qualify.
